### **Deputy Returning Officer**

- Sets up the poll
- Ensures that electors provide proof of ID and address
- Hands ballot to the elector and provides instructions
- Ensures that poll clerk and candidates' representatives follow procedures
- Counts the ballots, completes the related forms and informs the Elections Canada office of the results

### **Poll Clerk**

- Helps the deputy returning officer set up and open the poll
- Helps the deputy returning officer ensure that voting proceeds in an orderly fashion
- Locates the elector's name on the list of electors and crosses it out
- Helps count the ballots

### **Central Poll Supervisor**

- Ensures that polls are set up on time
- Supervises poll workers
- Supervises the counting of the ballots
- Manages the collection and return of ballot boxes

### **Registration Officer**

- Sets up the registration desk
- Explains the registration process
- Verifies ID and address information
- Completes the registration form for eligible electors

### **Information Officer**

- Directs electors to the appropriate table
- Informs electors about accepted proof of identity and address
- Directs the orderly flow of people in the polling station
- Ensures that the poll closes on time and that electors have exercised their right to vote
